The Higher Population Council (HPC) is the national reference body for all demographic issues and information related to population and development. The HPC's programs focus on a set of priorities of population and development issues so as people can reach to the state of recovery as well as social, economic and health well-being, through achieving sustainable and equitable growth that is based on the National Population Strategy perspective; responding to the forced and voluntary immigration challenges; enhancing gender equality; empowering women and youth; strengthening sexual and reproductive health and rights; and integrating demographic dimension into national development plans.

Through its programs, HPC works to strengthen the capacity of government institutions, the private sector and civil society organizations to support the achievement of the goals of the International Conference on Population and Development 1994 and the Commitments of the Nairobi Summit 2019, especially with regard to reproductive health and gender-based violence, with a focus on improving the health and well-being of women, adolescents, youth, people with disabilities and the elderly, as well as supporting the implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals agenda in line with Jordan's Vision 2025.

HPC cooperates with government agencies, civil society organizations, the private sector, research centers and international organizations to address obstacles to health and development. HPC also has partnerships with policy makers and donors to support the implementation of relevant national policies. In addition, it hosts a global network for research on development and reproductive health.
